SHARK DAYS Of July!

While August may see the dog days, this July seems to be the shark days, as the finned favorites pop up in many incarnations, from the fantasy of the latest *Sharknado* movie (later in this issue), to the annual documentary favorites seen during Discovery Channel's Shark Week and Nat Geo Wild's SharkFest. SHARK WEEK — July 5-12 on Discovery Channel. Discovery's long-running event (now in its 28th year) promises the most hours of programming in its history. New specials will include the first ever Shark Week expedition to Cuba, plus other global locations including New Zealand, South Africa, Taiwan and the Arctic, along with numerous U.S. destinations. Sequels to favorite Shark Week specials will be featured, including another *Air Jaws* installment. The popular late-night talk show *Shark After Dark* will also be back (July 5-9), hosted by filmmaker and actor Eli Roth.

SHARKFEST — July 5-12 on Nat Geo Wild. Not as old as Shark Week, this event goes up against its elder for the first time this year, offering its own shark specials. It kicks off with *Shark Alley*, and also includes the special *United Sharks of America*, about the sharks that roam America's coastlines.

POP-CULTURE SHARKS

The longevity of Shark Week, and the addition of SharkFest, is a testament to how, throughout history, sharks have always frightened and intrigued us. That duality has made it understandable that the creatures would also turn up in our popular culture. Here are some notable instances.



JAWS — Celebrating 40 years of scaring moviegoers out of the water (it hit theaters in June 1975), Steven Spielberg's suspense masterpiece is probably the most responsible for the increased interest in sharks.

JABBERJAW — Created amid the shark mania, this cartoon series actually

featured a good-natured shark.

LAND SHARK — Also inspired by the success of *Jaws*, this character from the early days of *Saturday Night Live* was voiced by Chevy Chase. It spoofed

Jaws by having people not even safe from a killer shark while on land.

SHARKS FROM DEEP BLUE SEA — Costar Samuel L. Jackson memorably gets gobbled up by a shark in one of the movie's most famous and unexpected scenes.

BRUCE FROM FINDING NEMO —



The *Jaws* shadow even reached to this 2003 Pixar

favorite, that featured a great white shark named Bruce, in a nod to the

unofficial name given to the mechanical shark used in the 1975 thriller (it was jokingly named after Steven Spielberg's lawyer).

SHARK TALE — DreamWorks' answer to *Finding Nemo* was this animated feature that included a mob family of sharks (with its leader voiced by Robert De Niro).

KING SHARK — A DC Comics supervillain, this humanoid shark has battled Superboy and Aquaman.

SHARKNADO FRANCHISE — This Syfy original movie franchise is now on its third installment, premiering this month.

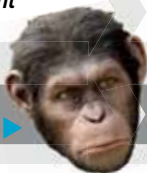

OH HELL YES!

David Hasselhoff
May Steal The Spotlight In
"Sharknado 3: Oh Hell No!"

It was probably fitting that David Hasselhoff signed on to appear in Syfy's *Sharknado 3: Oh Hell No!*, the third in its ongoing film franchise that has been a pop-culture hit, especially on social media. Hasselhoff had already appeared in another purposely cheesy killer fish movie, 2012's *Piranha 3DD*, and the actor referred to that previous title a few times in our interview as he explained why these types of movies are so bad they're good.

Hasselhoff has embraced that tongue-in-cheek aspect of his career as a whole, as well (and one could feel that sense of fun he has about himself and his work in our interview). Telling us he has become "synonymous with the '80s" thanks to his former TV shows *Knight Rider* and *Baywatch*, the actor clearly recognizes the draw of nostalgia, irony and, yes, cheesiness among various generations. Earlier this year, he had an online hit with the music video for the song "True Survivor," which was featured in the Kickstarter-funded short film *Kung Fury*. In it, Hasselhoff jumped and karate-kicked around in a knowing and fun throwback to videos of 30 years past. As of this writing, the video had over 10 million views after being up only a month ("it's just taken over the world," Hasselhoff tells us), and is further solidifying his reputation among a new generation.

Sharknado 3 looks to do the same. With its increased number of celebrity appearances, and locations ranging from D.C. to Orlando – and even outer space, as Hasselhoff tells us – it could be the biggest and craziest entry in the franchise yet. Before his tongue-in-cheek sign-off to our interview with the phrase "May the Hoff be with you," Hasselhoff elaborated more about the movie that he has previously, and happily, said will be the "worst movie you have ever seen."

Tell us about your character in *Sharknado 3*, and why you were drawn to this franchise.


David Hasselhoff: I play Fin's [Ian Ziering] father. It's more than a cameo. I help him save the world, and we bond, get very close in the movie, kind of create a little bit of a backstory. It's very funny what happens to me, and very heartwarming in the end. I love the idea because the script was actually good, and it actually gave me something to play with. I'd seen *Sharknado 1*, and I thought it was hysterical. And I really liked No. 2, the way they used all the cameos, and it's really funny. I think people watch it because, like *Piranha 3DD*, they want to see how bad and how over the top it is, and I think that's the beauty of the film. People really get it, and it brings the world together on one night, with giant sharks taking over the world. It's just so ridiculous that it's funny.

You said in a recent interview that this would be the worst movie audiences have ever seen. How is the franchise upping the ante in so-bad-it's-good awfulness this time around, both in general and in your specific scenes? Any *Baywatch* references in your scenes?

No *Baywatch* references during my scenes, but I'm not sure for the rest of the movie. The specific scenes that I'm in are that my character is an astronaut. And I float off into space, and you'll have to watch the movie to see what happens to me, but when I said it was the worst movie ever made I said that with a smile in my eyes, and actually comparing it to *Piranha 3DD*. They're both pretty bad movies, but that's why they're really entertaining. [The movie] really takes place a lot in outer space, and the space shuttle, Cape Canaveral, and it really went – they have a lot of guest stars in it this year. That's going to make it really fun to see who gets eaten next.

Was *Sharknado 3* a pretty active role for you, with a lot of running around and stunt work?

It wasn't a lot of stunt work, which is great because I just had both of my knees worked on after being on the road for seven months, and singing and dancing and doing my concerts. I was pretty worn out from the *Knight Rider* and *Baywatch* days, so I had some work done on my knees, and I was not really in the best of mobility when the movie started. But good news is [my character] was floating a lot in outer space and I got to sit down a lot. The sharks, I think the sharks are really the stars, because every time a star comes in, it's like, "Who's going to get eaten?" It's pretty funny, actually.

Do you think there will be a *Sharknado 4*? If there is, would you like to continue your involvement (assuming you're not eaten by a shark in this one)?

Yeah. There will probably be 10 *Sharknados*. This is such a phenomenon that – the best part about this movie is that little kids will watch it, like under 13 or 14, and they'll be really scared, they'll take it seriously. Between 14 and 20, they'll look at it as probably really stupid – "I'm not going to watch it." And 20- to 40-year-olds are really going to get the joke and are going to watch it to see how hysterically bad it is, and some of the lines are just so over the top. I am sure what happens to my character at the end of this, and I'm sure that I'll be back for *Sharknado 4* if I'm available. I'd love to come in and do something with *Sharknado 4*. It's great to be a part of the team; it's just such a Twitter phenomenon and reaches such a widespread, crazy audience. It's kind of what my life's about – it's like, you know, let's have fun and don't take life so seriously, because when you do it usually gets you in trouble.

The Jim Gaffigan Show

Comedian, Dad, Food-Eater. Explore Jim's Funny World
In His New Series. By Kellie Freeze

The *Jim Gaffigan Show* feels like a family business. It stars comedian Jim Gaffigan as a fictionalized version of himself – a food- and nap-loving devoted father of five, who is raising his brood of fair-haired kids in a two-bedroom apartment in New York City. Gaffigan also writes and produces the scorchingly funny series with his wife and writing partner Jeannie, and while the three of us chat on the phone, they're joined by their 3-year-old Michael (child No. 4), who entertains us before departing with a charmingly lisped "Thanks! Thanks! Thanks! Thank you!" Clearly,

performing is in the youngster's blood, and while I'd like to say the apple doesn't fall far from the tree, it's more apropos to say the ham doesn't fall far from the bacon. And I'm sure Jim – the best-selling author of books *Dad Is Fat* and *Food: A Love Story* – would droolingly agree.

"Jim's point of view is the id of us all," says Jeannie. "Because everyone has the secret desire to eat more bacon than they give you in a restaurant. For Jim, it's just saying it, and we're laughing because we relate to it."

"I love playing a smart dumb guy," Jim admits. "There's a little bit of what Homer Simpson does, really." When asked how he differs from his performing personas, he explains, "I would say that Real-Life Jim is smarter than Standup Jim, and Standup Jim is smarter than *The Jim Gaffigan Show* Jim."

While Jim is playing a heightened and fictionalized version of himself on the show, Jeannie is keeping her talents behind the scenes, a decision that was made to ensure that their vision for the show remained intact. "Who's going to police the police?" she ponders.

"The point of view of the entire show, from wardrobe to casting to locations, is all Jim and Jeannie. We're grateful for that," Jim says. And Jeannie adds, "It's not going to be about money anymore. It's going to be about creative fulfillment."

"Jeannie and I have been on this long journey with this idea of this show, this autobiographical thing about our lives," he says. "But really when it comes down to it, we wanted to do a show that we would want to watch."

And since the duo calls the shots, one of their most provocative and most buzz-garnering decisions was to release an episode of the show on the comedian's website two months before it premieres on TV Land. "We wanted to post an episode to show that – in a crude way – that it's not junk," says Jim. "Hopefully when it comes up in early July at a barbecue or whatever, and someone is like, '*The Jim Gaffigan Show*,' if they're in a crowd of four people, one of them might have seen it."

After being available for less than two weeks, the episode, titled "The Bible Story," in which Jim worries about being "outed" as a Catholic, has been viewed more than 250,000 times. "This episode is a pretty off-the-wall episode," says Jeannie. "You'd think that a comedy might not get into doing something like that, or at least until the end of their season, or maybe even later seasons." But Gaffigan has been made famous by boldly admitting to things that other comedians may hide, such as a love for McDonald's fast food.

If Gaffigan is the least cool – and most honest – comedian in any room, surrounding him on the show are incredible actors who are his character's polar opposites.

Adam Goldberg plays Jim's cynical comic friend Dave, who views Jim's "normal" lifestyle of a wife and children with the same mild revulsion of someone watching sausage get made. "We know that when Jim and Adam work together, there's just going to be this magic that happens," says Jeannie. Michael Ian Black plays Jeannie's gay best friend Daniel, who is also Jim's biggest critic. "Michael Ian Black's character is very similar to a mother-in-law character," laughs

Jim. "The husband is never good enough for the wife." Jeannie says of Gaffigan and Black's working friendship, which goes back over 20 years, "Michael can make Jim crack up, and you have to do the scene five times because Michael, he just comes up with these really funny one-liners that no one has ever heard before."

When Jim was looking for someone to portray the onscreen version of his wife, he found her in actress Ashley Williams, who impressed him with her Jeannie-like energy, her giant mom-like backpack and her goofy charm. "Ashley Williams could come at Jim – my character – with a machine gun and people would find

it adorable. That's very rare in an actress," he says.

The Wall Street Journal once called Gaffigan "the king of (clean) comedy," and it's true – his witty observational humor doesn't have to use profanity, vulgarity or insults to get a laugh. But Jim and Jeannie remind us that *The Jim Gaffigan Show* isn't Jim's standup routine and is chock-full of fantastic cameos including Chris Rock, Jon Stewart and even Steve Buscemi, so don't expect Jim's friends to play by his family-friendly rules.

"It's an adult show; it's adult-themed," says Jeannie. "Not adult like dirty, but adult like Jim's friend telling him that he needs to get a vasectomy. Things like that. You don't think of it as that adult-themed, but even when we were writing, my 8-year-old said, 'What's a vasectomy?' And I said, 'Oh, it's just some operation that some men have so they don't have babies anymore.' And he said, 'But men don't have babies!'"

Touché. Add fact-checker to the list of adorable roles in the Gaffigan family business.

DENIS LEARY IS
GETTING THE BAND
BACK TOGETHER.

Remember when a rock band's fame was measured in record sales and radio plays instead of Twitter followers and trending hashtags? Someone might as well stick us in a museum with a pole up our butts because we, like Johnny Rock, are fossils.

Comedian and former *Rescue Me* star Denis Leary returns to FX in the new comedy *Sex & Drugs & Rock & Roll* as Johnny Rock, the drugged-out, aging frontman of early '90s flash-in-the-pan punk band The Heathens. For nearly 25 years, he's been living all of the rock star lifestyle with none of the fame or fortune.

John Corbett costars as Flash, The Heathens' former guitarist who's now enjoying anonymous success playing in Lady Gaga's backing band. "We had a band that broke up the same day our record came out in the early '90s and we all went our separate ways," Corbett explains. "And Denis' character, Johnny Rock, hasn't changed his ways in 20-plus years. He's just down and out in New York trying to scrape a buck together to get a shot of booze. And this young girl comes up and says, 'You're my daddy. I've got lots of money and I'm a great singer, and I want you to get the band back together again and write some songs for me.'"

Enter sexy scene-stealing siren Elizabeth Gillies as Johnny's daughter, Gigi. "I didn't know him growing up, so I'm on the hunt for my father because I want my father figure back, but also because I want him to make me famous," Gillies says. "The band reluctantly re-forms, and I surprise them a little bit." Jaws drop when Gigi grabs the mic for the first time in front of Johnny's band. Yes, the actors all play their instruments and that really is Gillies performing the vocals.

"She can sing anything," Leary says. "Man, I'm the luckiest guy in television right now to have this girl working for me." He recalls how Gillies nailed a song in her character's breakout live performance. "It's *flawless*," he says. "I wish I had her wisdom and ability when I was 21 years old."

Sex&Drugs&Rock&Roll plays the generational differences for laughs, but more effectively mocks what it means to be famous in the 21st century.

"I've been famous for 25 years now," Leary says. "It's never been as blanket a case in society, especially in America, where everybody wants to be famous and you can become famous simply for social media or selling yourself that way. It's fair game. Johnny doesn't understand that, but that's the way the world works.

"My kids didn't know who Paul Newman was. They thought he was a chef," Leary continues. "Fame is so fleeting for almost all of us. But the one weird thing is music. Great music carries through — great classical music, great jazz, great rock 'n' roll songs — those are the things in fame that last forever. I don't think Johnny's going to make that boat. Gigi will, and I think that's the closest he'll get to it."

Sex&Drugs&Rock&Roll has a lot of good tunes, and a few songs that are bad on purpose, like these:

"An Gorta Mor" The Heathens' bass player, Rehab (John Ales), recorded this overwrought 29-song cycle about the Irish Potato Famine. Chris Phillips, Denis Leary's longtime collaborator, composed and recorded some of the songs to appear in the show. Upon hearing them, Leary told Phillips, "Dude, this is fantastic! It sounds like Rehab spent all of his money in the studio. This is fantastic! This is so incredibly expensive and bad!"

"Sinner's Gold" Johnny tries to write a song while sober, and he comes up with the introspective, adult-contemporary "Sinner's Gold." Leary recalls, "Liz [Gillies] came into the studio and we played it for her, and we didn't tell her that it was a joke song. And when I got done playing, I just looked at her and she went, 'Ummm ...' And she didn't know what to say. And I said, 'It's supposed to be bad.' And she went, 'Oh my God! Thank God. It's horrible.' But if Sting sang that song, he'd get laid."

Being an ancient Egyptian pharaoh must have been a pretty good gig. You sat around all day drinking beer while half-nude ladies fed you figs and slaves erected monuments in your honor. What they don't tell you in the job interview is the part about foreign invaders, plagues, famines, civil unrest, and all your aides, generals and priests conspiring against you.

Spike gets back into scripted projects with the ambitious three-night, six-hour event *Tut*, dramatizing boy king Tutankhamun's brief but famous reign and struggle to return Egypt to greatness. Avan Jogia (*Twisted*) plays Tut, with screen legend Ben Kingsley playing Tut's scheming top adviser.

What's it like to have a knighted Oscar winner bow to you? "It was kind of a cool experience. Sir Ben is just the most generous actor, thoughtful and helpful, very giving," Jogia says. "He doesn't take a role that he doesn't show passion about."

With lavish sets, large-scale battles, political backstabbing and sex hotter than the Sahara, *Tut* succeeds at emulating Egypt's grandeur. "It's a civilization that didn't change much for the better part of 3,000 years, and it didn't do that by being small about it," Jogia says.

At its heart, though, *Tut* is a very human story. "The story we tell is of a boy turning into a man who is trying to take back his kingdom and do right by his people," Jogia says.

What *Tut* doesn't attempt to do is be a history textbook. It won't, for example, explore the hypothesis that Tut was killed by a hippo. "That's not how we go out," Jogia laughs. "Being eaten by a hippopotamus is maybe not as interesting a story."

Golden Globe Winner Jon Voight Talks Season 3. By Lori Acken

"Whenever things get bad, they could always get worse: Mickey could show up," grins *Ray Donovan* star Jon Voight — who thrills audiences weekly as Clan Donovan's hustling patriarch — in a teaser for the show's third season.

So now that his fortunes have changed, courtesy of a fine day at the horse track, does that mean Mickey *with* money is even more of a loose cannon than he was perpetually chasing it? "The more he has, the more dangerous he becomes to himself and others," Voight confirms of the newly flush guy with his eye on becoming a prostitution kingpin. "He's not a different animal. There can be a calm in the sea where it *looks* like it's a calm, but it's a whirlpool, really. You don't get too close to it, or you'll go down under with him."

That's something Mickey's sons know only too well, none more so than Liev Schreiber's bitter Hollywood fixer Ray, who — with his home life and his empire in a shambles — finds himself in the service of L.A. powerbroker Andrew Finney (*Deadwood's* Ian McShane) and his daughter Paige (Katie Holmes). And though previews show Mick and Ray toasting each other poolside in matching tropical shirts, Voight says don't be too quick to buy the sunny scene.

"I think Mickey would like *not* to be dangerous to his environment — especially to his family. But he is," Voight says. "Ray's got the same kind of thing. He's somebody who's going to be called upon by morally questionable folks to do morally questionable things. That's how he makes his living. It's very, very hard for either one of them to change."

Still, Voight says, no one knows (and loves) Ray-Ray like his dad.

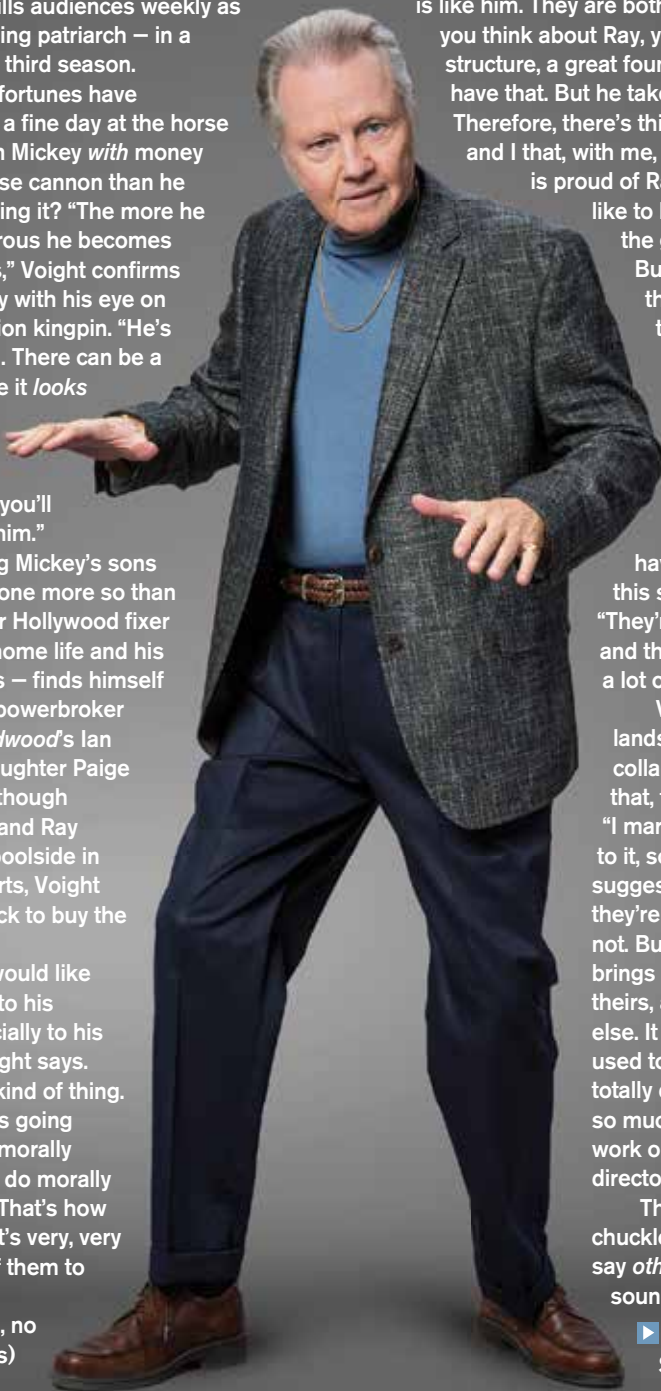
"The injury is great with Ray," he explains. "Ray knows Mickey very well, because Ray, in a certain sense, is like him. They are both alpha males — but when you think about Ray, you may think about a strong structure, a great foundation. Mickey doesn't seem to have that. But he takes the lead. He runs the show. Therefore, there's this kind of standoff between Ray and I that, with me, comes from admiration. Mickey is proud of Ray. He thinks he's *like* Ray. He'd like to be like Ray, but he doesn't have the grace that Ray has. The poise. But he knows enough to see that this guy is a remarkable guy. I think he cares more for Ray than anyone else in life."

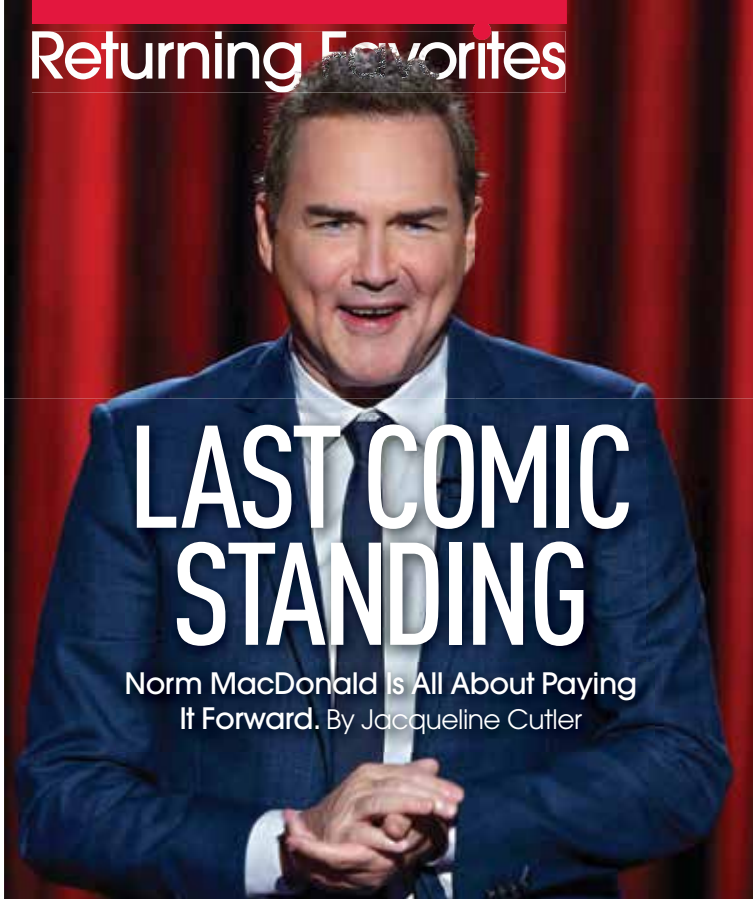
Season 3 also brings complex story arcs for Mickey's other sons — Terry (Eddie Marsan), Bunchy (Dash Mihok) and Darryl (Pooch Hall). "The boys have a lot to do with the story of this season," Voight says proudly. "They're such good actors, these guys, and their characters are so unique. It's a lot of fun."

Voight says the changing TV landscape has created a quality, collaborative working environment that, for him, recalls early Hollywood. "I marinate a scene before I get to it, so I've got a lot of thoughts, suggestions that I make. Sometimes they're right on, and sometimes they're not. But I bring my thoughts and Liev brings his, and the directors bring theirs, and then it becomes something else. It becomes something better. It used to be that film and television were totally different animals. Now, it's not so much of a difference. I'm able to work on this character with other great directors and actors."

Then the man who plays Mickey chuckles slyly and adds, "I shouldn't say *other* great actors. Makes me sound like I'm one of them."

Norm MacDonald Is All About Paying It Forward. By Jacqueline Cutler

Norm MacDonald emits a vibe of genuine decency, much like Jimmy Stewart and Tom Hanks. It can't be faked, much as politicians may try.

MacDonald, 51, takes his place at the judges' table with Roseanne Barr (his old boss from his days as a writer on *Roseanne*) and Keenen Ivory Wayans when *Last Comic Standing* returns this month. After decades as a standup (he still does some 250 gigs annually), MacDonald has the experience to impart wisdom to those trying to make it in such a tough field.

"Standup is more like a craft than an art so it can be learned more," MacDonald says from his Los Angeles home. "An artistic endeavor is more open to interpretation. With standup, because there is an audience, it has to laugh, it has to make this particular noise all at the same time.

"It is almost all language," MacDonald continues, citing his top advice. "And taking out words is probably the biggest thing you can do. Just omit words, omit words, omit words. And understand that the audience is usually ahead of you anyway. Sometimes when you start, you overstate the premise too

much. They don't have to hear that or the premise is so weak and has to be stated. Brevity, I guess, would be a really important one especially nowadays, because no one wants anything long."

MacDonald, who is from Quebec City, went to *SNL* and had the coveted anchor spot on "Weekend Update" from 1994-97 after leaving *Roseanne*. A bunch of sitcoms and movies followed – *Norm*, *A Minute With Stan Hooper*, *Grown Ups* – yet all along he stuck with standup.

Much like he credits David Letterman – "he was more like a hero of mine, more than a friend" – MacDonald pays it forward with *Last Comic Standing*, helping contestants refine their acts. Like every comedian, MacDonald has bombed, has endured a night of jokes that went so far south it haunts him years later. "I was at a bar and I heard what I thought were gunshots," MacDonald says. "And a guy in the front row was throwing firecrackers at my feet in Oshawa, Canada. I had been having a bad set before that."

Aden Young Talks About Daniel Having To Walk Away From Life In Paulie.

When last we laid eyes upon Daniel Holden as the second season of SundanceTV's *Rectify* drew to a close,

he was sitting pensively in the hallway of the Paulie County Courthouse, awaiting the final word on a plea deal he had just signed that would

see him banished from his hometown.

Brilliantly portrayed by Aden Young, Daniel is a man who has been grappling with lots of demons since his release from prison, where he spent 19 years after having confessed to the rape and murder of his teenage girlfriend. Released after conflicting DNA evidence was found, Daniel has spent most of his time since then trying to adjust to life on the outside, surrounded by the loyalty of his family and the distrust of others still convinced of his guilt.

SundanceTV's first original series, *Rectify* won a Peabody Award last year for its slow but powerful depiction of Daniel's tortured journey. "We're all very proud of it," the 43-year-old Young says of the series over the phone from New York City. "To be a part of something that, I think, is very special – it's a great honor." And, as Season 3 gets ready to roll, there will be plenty more in store.

"The show begins, literally, an hour after Season 2 finishes and he's got 30 days to, you know, get out of Dodge. And he's confronted by the reality of what he's just done," Young says. "He's now on parole, he's on probation, and he's got to deal with all those very restrictive authority scenarios once again. And the one thing we know about Daniel [is that] authority has never been his best friend. There's a lot going on, before Daniel can walk away from his life in Paulie."

On the wings of my fancy, I can fly anywhere, and the world will open its arms to me."

It was a poignant moment for reasons well beyond the charming sight of a pretty little girl singing a princess song to her famous guest – because Jazz Jennings was born an anatomical boy, but knew from the time she understood the difference between genders that she is, unquestionably, a girl. And from that time on, she's been on a mission to make the world open its arms to her exactly as she is.

Jazz's parents, Greg and Jeanette Jennings, enlisted a team of specialists who diagnosed Jazz with gender dysphoria and are guiding her along the path to adulthood in a culture that can be cruelly narrow-minded. In a short amount of time, NBC Sports has filled out its front row with the big three auto-racing leagues. NBCSN (then Versus) began its IndyCar coverage in 2009, then picked up Formula One rights starting in 2013. This month, NBC is back in the NASCAR game for the first time since 2006, effectively making its networks the top destinations for race fans and giving NASCAR a cross-promotional boost with NBC's Sunday primetime NFL games.

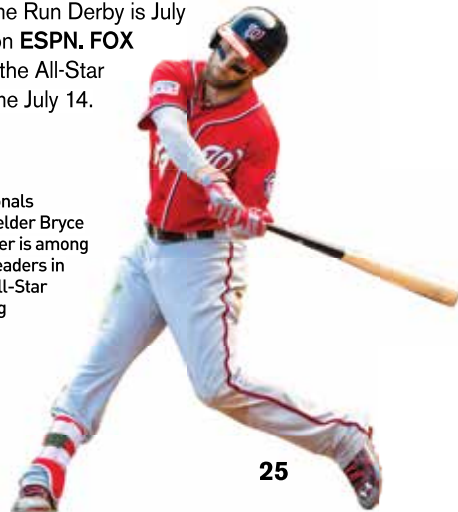

HUNGRY For Something Different

Jena Malone Ranks “Hunger Games”
Films Close To The Top In Her Film
Resumé. By Barb Oates

Back in 1996 we were first introduced to Jena Malone, a confident 11-year-old making her film debut in one of TV’s most wrenching and controversial movies of the time. Malone played a child who was sexually and physically abused by her stepfather in the film adaptation of Dorothy Allison’s novel *Bastard Out of Carolina*. Fast-forward 20 years later and countless beloved films she’s starred in – *Contact*, *Stepmom*, *For Love of the Game*, *Sucker Punch* – and Malone ranks her role as Johanna Mason in *The Hunger Games* film franchise as one of her favorites.

“It ranks pretty high in my book, for sure,” Malone tells us, while discussing the debut of *The Hunger Games: Mockingjay – Part 1* on EPIX this month. “Because of the experience and the family atmosphere on set – we all ended up really falling in love with each other and creating such a family.”

The familial cast includes an impressive list of talent, most notable being Jennifer Lawrence in the lead as Katniss Everdeen, Josh Hutcherson, Liam Hemsworth, Elizabeth Banks, Woody Harrelson, Donald Sutherland, Julianne Moore, Willow Shields, Jeffrey Wright, Sam Claflin, Natalie Dormer and the late Philip Seymour Hoffman.

Malone adds that the film also ranks high for her because it “was a first for me in getting to build a character over an arc of three films, which I had never done. It’s a rarity and a gift as an actor to do that and have that breadth and that time.”

The films’ dystopian premise centers around 12 oppressed districts all forced to offer two tributes – one boy and one girl, determined through a lottery system – to participate in the country’s annual Hunger Games, where the tributes battle each other until only one living person remains.

“These are very thinly veiled stories about war and what it’s like to go hungry and what it’s like to live in a wartime,” Malone says about the widespread appeal of the films. “I think it’s really courageous and really beautiful that the sort of teenagers of the world are saying, ‘I want these stories. I want these myths and I want to know what it’s really like.’ It definitely inspired me to take a better look at the kind of narratives we are giving our children because I think they are hungry for something different.”

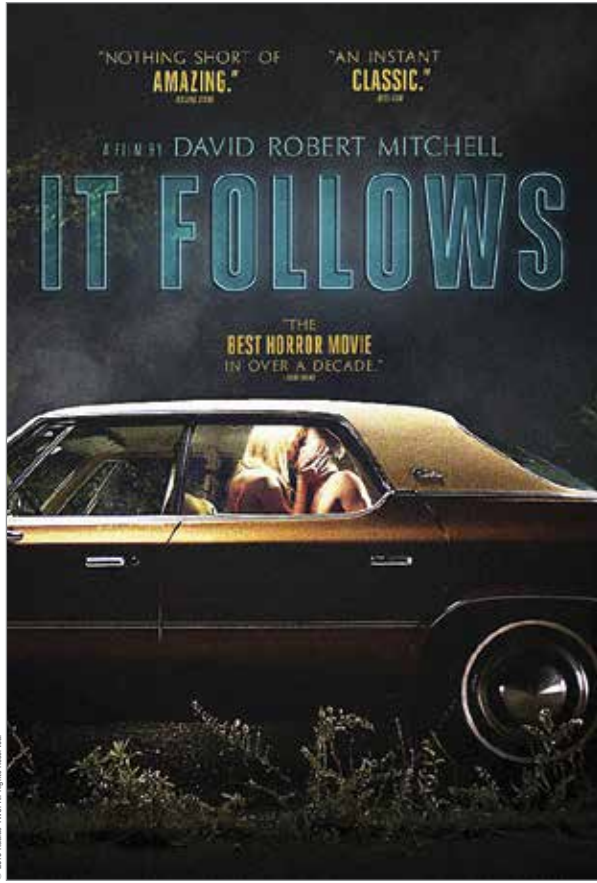

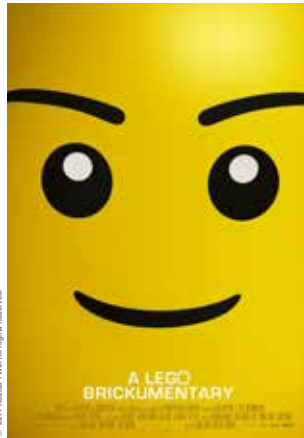

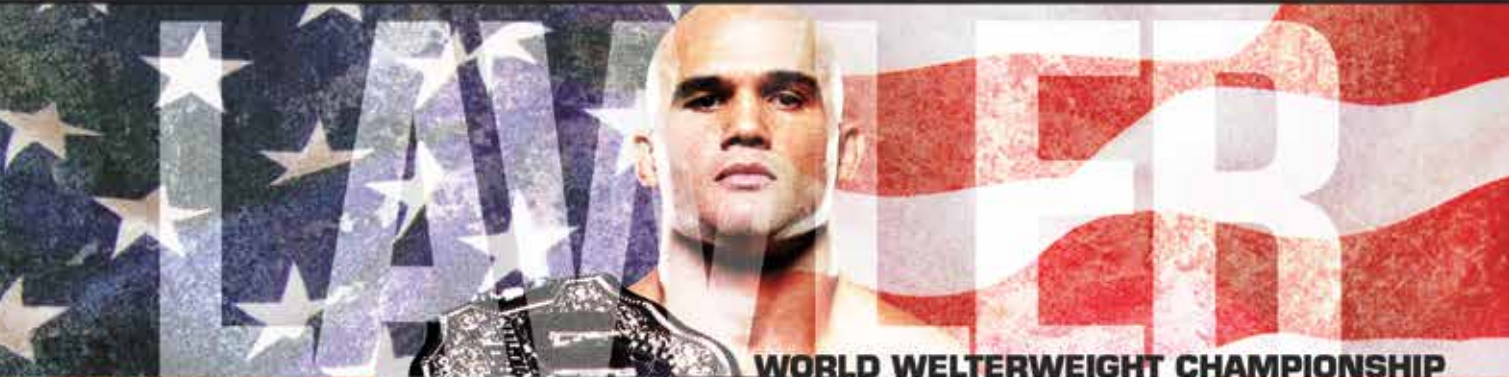
